

THE APPROXIMATE LIMITS OF THE GREAT CURRENTS AND DRIFTS OF THE OCEAN

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The open shading indicates the limits of permanent currents and drifts modified by seasons but not reversed. The dotted shading indicates the limits of currents and drifts which are governed by monsoons and other local winds. The angle arrows in the monsoon districts indicate the prevailing one of the currents or drifts during the season. The arrows indicate the direction of the current or drift.
