



# MAP OF THE AMU-DARYA-CASPIAN WATER ROUTE

FOR OPENING A DIRECT WATER COMMUNICATION  
FROM THE AFGHAN FRONTIER  
TO ST. PETERSBURGH AND THE BALTIC  
BY THE AMU-DARYA, ITS OLD BED, THE CASPIAN SEA, THE VOLGA AND THE BALTIC  
WATER SYSTEM.

SHOULD A RAILWAY BE BUILT FROM THE SOURCE OF THE AMU-DARYA  
TO THAT OF THE INDUS, THIS ROAD MIGHT FORM A DIRECT STEAM INDO-  
AMU-DARYA ROUTE FROM INDIA TO THE BLACK SEA AND THE BALTIC.

DISTANCE IN VERSTS. (a 1000 = 666 mls.)

- 1. From Pushkovo to the Amu-Darya, by the Amu-Darya, its old bed, the Caspian Sea, through Baku to Baku. 1700 v. by rail, 2,200 by water, together 4000 v. = 2,664 miles.
- 2. From Pushkovo to St. Petersburg by rail to the Amu-Darya, by the Amu-Darya, its old bed, the Caspian Sea, the Volga and the Baltic Water System. 850 v. by rail, 6,520 by water, together 7370 v. = 4,914 miles.
